Not email. Not Informed Delivery. Not FedEx. Official mail only.

Plain answers

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Email vs eMbox

Question	Email	eMbox
Tied to home address	No	Yes
Verified senders only	No	Yes
Blocks marketing solicitation	No	Yes
Legal delivery proof	No	Yes
Discreet (app-only option)	Partial	Yes

FedEx, DHL, UPS & Couriers

FedEx, DHL, and UPS move parcels with tracking numbers. They do not deliver certified bank, IRS, or insurer notices with address-bound proof. Couriers and eMbox can coexist — boxes via carrier, official mail via eMbox.

Rule: Track parcels with carriers. Deliver official bank, IRS, and insurer mail with eMbox.

Clean Inbox · Zero Solicitation

Eliminates solicitation

- Allowlist-only — enrolled institutions with verified certs
- No insurance lead gens, political flyers, or phishing in the vault
- Valpak and catalogs may still hit the old mailbox — not eMbox

Cleans your email

- Banks, IRS, insurers move to eMbox — Gmail for people again
- Fewer fake official emails competing with real promos
- Push only from verified senders

Discreet by design

- App-only: nothing new on the curb
- Outdoor display: Bank · 1 — never document text
- You choose who knows you upgraded delivery

Informed Delivery & Portals

USPS Informed Delivery: Previews paper — same vulnerable box.

Bank portals: One login per institution — no address-bound proof across senders.

eMbox: One vault, verified senders, proof to your home.
